For general POM ACO GPRO Collection details, dates, instructions, documentation, and an

email repository, we are using POM ACO's website: www.pom-aco.com. The "GPRO Collection" page has been updated and new pages have been added, the details of which are below:

When you go to "GPRO Collection," please note that the abstractor list has been updated. If there are additions or deletions, please let me know. Note that our abstractor email contact list is taken directly from this list.

When you go to "Key Dates," please note that I've added the November 15th *Enterprise Identity Management (EIDM) for ACOs* webinar. Also, I added a PDF version of an Outlook calendar I created to track the project. Look for the link at the top of the page.

I added a new page called "Setting Up Abstractor Access to GPRO WI." This has steps on how to—obviously—set up your abstractor access to the GPRO WI. Before you go there, please read the "Setting Up GPRO WI Access" section below.

I updated the "Documentation for Abstractors" page and added documents that are referenced in the "Setting up Abstractor Access to GPRO WI" page. If you have a document that you want added to this list, please let me know.

Setting Up GPRO WI Access

Because submission of patient-level data is completed through the GPRO WI (Web Interface), abstractors must request access from CMS. The new "Setting up Abstractor Access to GPRO WI" page walks you through this process and references CMS-written documents for the step-by-step portion.

PLEASE NOTE, that only **new** abstractors have to follow all the steps. **Already registered** abstractors have been updated by the POM ACO Security Officer. You may want to see if you have access and/or update your profile. To do so, use the document referenced in #3.
